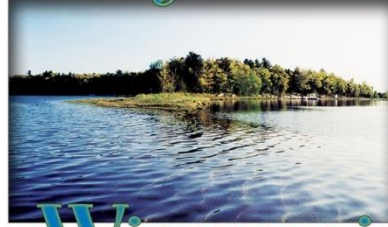


Berry Lake



Wisconsin

The following rules apply to all people on Berry Lake at all times...owners, renters, guests, friends, and people using the boat landing. **Please refer to the Wisconsin Boating Regulations pamphlet that you receive with your boat registration – State DNR laws apply and are enforced by local authorities.**

BOATING/PERSONAL WATER CRAFT OPERATION (PWC)

- High speed boat and PWC operation are allowed on the lake from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM everyday (10:00 AM until sunset if sunset is before 8:00 PM), and must be in a COUNTER-CLOCKWISE direction
- From 8:00 PM until 10:00 AM travel must be at “slow no-wake”
- All persons in the boat must have an approved flotation device
- It is unlawful to operate a motorboat within 100 feet of any dock, raft, pier, or buoyed restricted area at a speed in excess of “slow-no-wake”
- PWCs must be at a slow-no-wake speed whenever within 200 feet of the shoreline
- Motorized crafts must yield the right-of-way to all sailboats and other non-motorized crafts

FIREARMS

- No firearms are to be discharged in the lake area at anytime (this includes BB guns)...the exception is during the duck hunting season when shotgun hunting on the lake is permissible

DUMPING

- No dumping in the lake area is allowed (this includes leaves)
- There is no garbage pickup at Berry Lake, and all garbage must be taken to the Underhill Town Dump. All garbage taken to the dump (other than recyclables) must be in specially marked “Town of Underhill” garbage bags, which can be purchased at the dump. Separate recycling bins are available there as well.

AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES

- It is unlawful to launch or use a boat, boat trailer, or boating equipment if there are any aquatic plants attached.
