

## BLPOA ANNUAL MEETING

Virtual meeting this year due to COVID 19 via Zoom

**Tuesday, May 19th @ 7:00 PM**

President Ben Waddell called the meeting to order. Kay reported that the Secretary's Report was available online and that the Treasurer's Report was mailed out to our email list prior to the meeting today. The minutes and report were MSA.

Kay reported that the Ice-Off winners this spring were the Cimoski's and the Echolm's, and Kay will get a prize for both families. No one guessed the actual date this year which was April 3, 2020, but these two families came closest..

Kay reported on summer events (hopefully we will be able to meet):

- 4th of July Boat Parade will take place on Saturday, July 4th at 2:00. All boat entries are to meet at the Point and proceed counterclockwise around the lake for all to see. The theme is "PATRIOTIC".
- The tentative annual Corn Boil date is Saturday, August 15th at the Northern Grace Youth Camp. We are still in need of someone to host a "Social" which takes place after lunch (all costs are covered by the BLPOA...contact us if you'd like to host this year...thanks!). It was suggested that all residents participate in a work day to pull EWM, and all agreed that a good time to do this would be after the Corn Boil and prior to the Social. More details coming on this...

Kay talked about our Clean Boats/Clean Waters efforts here and it was stressed again that all volunteer hours count towards money off of any future invasive species treatment here.

Residents can volunteer their time in two ways and are encouraged to do so:

- Volunteer your time at the boat landing to screen incoming/outgoing boaters. Complete info on CBCW boat landing procedures is located on the Citizen Lake Monitoring page of our website. - Pull weeds around your dock, and keep track of all family members that do so. Each family member needs their own volunteer sheet filled out for us to get credited. Carol Asselmeier forwarded an update on this year's lake treatment plan prior to the meeting and went over the details at this Zoom meeting.

5 new board members were approved (one is a replacement for Nancy Vlachina who is resigning from the board as they're selling their property here): Steve DePrey, Jim DePrey, Toni Larson, Gina Kozlik, and Lindsey Renteria. (FYI one of the 5 new board members will need to assume Nancy's position...her term is through 2022).

The 2021 boat parade was voted on, and the theme with the most votes was: OUTERSPACE
